

## Information on battery regulation

## The delivery of this equipment is a lithium battery.

In connection with the sale of batteries or rechargeable batteries, we are as a trader in accordance with battery regulation obliged to inform our customers of the following:



Please dispose of used batteries, as required by law - the disposal in household waste is strictly forbidden in the Battery Directive - to a municipal collection or give them free to the local trade from. From us got batteries you can free return after use with us or with sufficient postage to return to us by post.

Batteries containing harmful substances are marked with the symbol of a crossed carbage can, similar to the symbol shown on the left. Under the garbage can icon is the chemical name of the pollutant - in the example on the left "Cd" for cadmium. "Pb" stands for lead, "Hg" for mercury.

## Additional important notes:

Because of their high energy density lithium batteries can provide relatively high currents. In short, the batteries can blow up, burst, explode, in extreme cases, fire or put other materials on fire. therefore treat lithium batteries always necessary precautions. Avoid excessive mechanical stresses (throw, drop, pressure on the sheathing exercise) and dispose of lithium batteries only in a fully discharged or fully insulated state.
